MOUNT VERNON HISTORIC PRESERVATION COMMISSION
Tuesday, August 25, 2015

The Historic Preservation Commission met on August 25, 2015 at 5:30 p.m. Commission members present included Patty Westerkamp, Mary Evans, Sarah Kelly, Hugh Lifson, Ed Sauter, and Guy Booth.

The agenda item is a design review request made by Lance and Sarah Dickson for renovation of the front of their building, which is known as the Video Village building. Mr. and Mrs. Dickson had previously submitted plans for pre-review, and the plan submitted for a building permit remain the same. The contractor may have to alter the height of the front windows, depending on what is found after the brick façade that is now on the front of the building is removed. It is the plan of the owners to bring the front of the building back as close to the original front as possible. The new brick that had been added in the 1970's will be removed and new large windows will be put back where they had previously been located. This appears to be a well-designed project and will help in the overall ambiance of the commercial historic district. Sarah Kelly moved that the Commission approve the Certificate of Appropriateness for the construction plans. The motion was seconded by Guy Booth. The motion carried unanimously.
