August Crashes

Officers are conducting background investigations into the two remaining Reserve Officer applicants. One of the applicants was unable to successfully complete the physical agility requirements and was eliminated from testing.

GTSB- s.T.E.P. Enforcement

Officers conducted traffic enforcement throughout August more so during the August 25th through September 7th s.T.E.P. wave. Officers arrested 6 individuals during between August 25th and September 7th. Charges that were filed on these 6 individuals include OWI, Public Intoxication, Theft 3rd, Driving while revoked and Interference with Official Acts. Those charged by citation included speeding, expired registration, no insurance, defective windshield, allowing an unauthorized driver to operate a motor vehicle and driving while suspension. Additional enforcement during this time period was our effort to slow traffic down traffic in an attempt to make our roadways safer during the high volume of traffic that routinely takes place in conjunction with the Labor Day Holiday.

Other Enforcement

Officers had 12 arrests during August. Charges included, OWI, Theft, Assault, Altered Prescriptions, Public intoxication, Operation without consent, driving while suspended and Interference with official acts. Officers issued 23 citations that included 11 moving violations, 4 no insurance, 1 no registration, 7 no driver's license/suspensions.
