Supplying Residents of Mt. Vernon with Wood Mulch

The City of Mt. Vernon (here after referred to as “city”) will load and deliver the equivalent of one pickup truck full of wood chips (here after referred to as “mulch”) for a nominal fee of \$5.00. One dump truck full of mulch can be delivered for \$10.00. Delivery location must be within city limits. Requests for delivery can be placed at any time through City Hall. Loads can be delivered by city crews any time between April and October, throughout the duration of brush pickup. Delivery time will be coordinated through the Public Works Department. On the first Monday of every month during brush pickup, between 2:50 PM and 3:50 PM, city workers will be onsite at the mulch pile (currently located behind the Ambulance building) to load resident’s trucks with mulch. Loading will be done with a skid loader. No hand loading of vehicles will be done by city crews. Fee for loading is \$1.00 per load. Fee is to be paid to city hall. Resident is to provide receipt from city hall to worker loading mulch at time of loading. Resident must remain in their truck during the loading process. Residents can still access the mulch pile at any time throughout the year, and load out of the city mulch pile with their own forces or equipment at no cost.
