**November Police Report**

**Governor’s Traffic Safety Bureau (s.T.E.P.) Special Traffic Enforcement Program**

Our department along with departments across Iowa will be participating in an aggressive traffic enforcement event November 25<sup>th</sup> – December 1<sup>st</sup>, 2013. These high visibility projects are to ensure that traveler’s buckle up, slow down and drive responsibly in order to save lives and reduce crashes.

**Tenth Avenue Roundabout:**

Pavement marking changes have been made. Additional sign issues will be completed in the next week or so.

To this date there have been two crashes in Hwy 1 & 30 roundabout and one crash in the Tenth Avenue & 30 roundabout.

**RC RAIL & ASAC Youth substance use Sponsored Event:**

RC Rail and ASAC sponsored a presentation and discussion on youth substance use and the products that are being marketed by tobacco companies. 90% of tobacco users started when they were teenagers and the discussion was very informative and attendees were able to see specific products that target youth.

RC Rail is working with the Lisbon and Mount Vernon School Boards on making policy changes that include smokeless products.
