



APPENDIX V: Mount Vernon Worktrips by Walking or Biking Percentage per 2000 Census Block Group*

*NOTE: Census Block Groups can overlap between rural and urban areas. This map presents each Block Group as exhibiting a constant, uniform rate of walking or biking. In reality, this may not be the case. For instance, the 44.14 percent rate for walking or biking (displayed in red) could be explained by the presence of the large, concentrated student population at Cornell College, many of whom may not utilize cars for their daily transportation.
