MOUNT VERNON HISTORIC PRESERVATION COMMISSION
Saturday, March 24, 2018

The Historic Preservation Commission met on March 24, 2018 at 9:15 a.m. Members present were Robert Murphy, Patricia Westerkamp, Leah Rogers, Sara Kelly, Susan Hargus, and Guy Booth. Guests included Steven Maurice and Robert Wright. The purpose of the meeting was design review for porch repair at the house of Steven Maurice, 702 8th Ave. NW in Mount Vernon. The house is in the Cornell College historic district.

Steve gave a review of the repair work that needs to be done. The flooring of the front porch has deteriorated and needs to be replaced. Steve is requesting permission to use a composite material that has the appearance of natural wood. He feels the life expectancy of this flooring material is a minimum of 30 years. This will assist in the stability of the house and will help in the overall preservation of the property. Motion to approve a certificate of appropriateness was made by Sara Kelly, seconded by Susan Hargus. The motion passed unanimously.

Leah Rogers announced that the regular meeting for the month of April will be April 7. There could be design review, or at least preliminary review for a Cornell project.
